

DESIGNING A MUG

- Your mug design must fit into a 21cm x 9.9cm rectangle, which will wrap around from one side of the handle to the other
- To save time on the day of your booking, you can design your product before you arrive. You can do this by using a programme or website of choice. We recommend programs such as Photoshop and Illustrator, or websites such as Canva and PixIr
- Once you have created a design or found your image, it will need to be flipped horizontally in preparation for printing. If you aren't confident doing this, it can be done on the day with support from staff
- Save you finished design or image as a JPEG or PNG. You can either bring
 it to the Fab Lab on a memory stick or sent it ahead of you booking to
 fablab@library.gg. Remember to include your name, library card number
 and booking date/time
- If you plan to design your image on the day, remember to bring the photos/images you want to use on a memory stick
- Once printed, a mug will take a couple of minutes to press and approximately ten minutes to cool
- We supply mugs to print on at a cost of £4 each
