



## DESIGNING A TOTE BAG

- Your tote bag design must be no more than 36cm high and 33cm wide (A3 or A4 sublimation paper available)
- To save time on the day of your booking, you can design your product before you arrive. You can do this by using a programme or website of choice. We recommend programs such as Photoshop and Illustrator, or websites such as Canva and Pixlr
- Once you have created a design or found your image, it will need to be flipped horizontally in preparation for printing. If you aren't confident doing this, it can be done on the day with support from staff
- Save your finished design or image as a JPEG or PNG. You can either bring it to the Fab Lab on a memory stick or send it ahead of you booking to [fablab@library.gg](mailto:fablab@library.gg). Remember to include your name, library card number and booking date/time
- If you plan to design your image on the day, remember to bring the photos/images you want to use on a memory stick
- Once designed, a tote bag will take approximately ten minutes to make if the press is heating up from cold, or a couple of minutes if hot
- We supply natural colour tote bags for printing at a cost of £4 (1 sided, 1 design) or £6 (2 sides, 2 designs). Designs can be full colour
