


If I am thirsty, I can fill up my water bottle by the coffee machine on the ground floor.

The library service is free of charge except for printing and photocopying.








When I visit the library

I can sit down to read a book.	




















If I need to use the toilet I can go to the second floor bathrooms by the top of the stairs.
