IMPACT

A project is underway to **upgrade the Library's study facilities**. In 2025 the Hayward Room has been given a major refurbishment thanks to support from the John Ramplin Trust and the Social Investment Fund. The next step will be to invest in high-quality new furniture, as we seek to create a **world-class learning space** for the whole community.

The Hayward Room has long been a vital resource for school and university students, remote workers, mature students pursuing accountancy and other professional qualifications, and many more. Demand continues to grow, with more than 100 students using the space each week at peak times. However, despite its popularity, there's significant room for improvement. While the refurbishment is a fantastic start, there's still an urgent need to replace the ageing tables and chairs with better quality, more modern, and more comfortable furniture.

We have one new 'study pod' already – now we need your support to help us invest in seven more. Each pod consists of a large study table boasting built-in lighting and charging ports, with noise-dampening dividers to maintain privacy, plus comfortable chairs to allow for extended use. Crucially, these pods will **more than double the room's capacity** from 26 to 60.

Your support will ensure that everyone in Guernsey has free access to a world-class learning and development space – an investment in the future of our community.




VISION
